SUBJECT: Increase in the Trade Adjustment Assistance Federal Mileage Reimbursement; Employment and Training State Instruction Letter No. 11-08

PURPOSE: To provide guidance in adhering to the Employment and Training State Instruction Letter No. 11-08 concerning the revision to the State policy to increase in the Trade Adjustment Federal Mileage Reimbursement rate pursuant to transportation allowances, subsistence, job search allowances and relocation allowances under the Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) Program.

POLICY: Effective for the training week beginning October 30, 2011, and forward, the federal mileage reimbursement rate under the TAA Program increases from 50.5 cents to 51 cents per mile.

PROCEDURES:

All TAA Case Managers must comply with the attached State TAA Instruction Letter No. 11-08.

SUBJECT: Increase in the Trade Adjustment Assistance
Federal Mileage Reimbursement

ISSUANCE DATE: January 24, 2011


EFFECTIVE DATE: January 31, 2011

PURPOSE: To issue State policy concerning the increase in the federal mileage reimbursement rate pursuant to transportation allowances, subsistence, job search allowances, and relocation allowances under the Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) Program.

BACKGROUND: Effective for the training week beginning January 31, 2011, and forward, the federal mileage reimbursement rate under the TAA Program increases from 50 cents to 50.5 cents per mile. The TAA Program allows for payment of transportation or subsistence payments to attend training; out-of-area job search allowances; and job relocation allowances when the travel is outside a participant's commuting area.

ACTION: You are responsible for the implementation of the Trade policy within your agency.
